We accept any other suggestions that include ideas on enriching your campus life, managing and organizing information, books that are useful for research, etc.

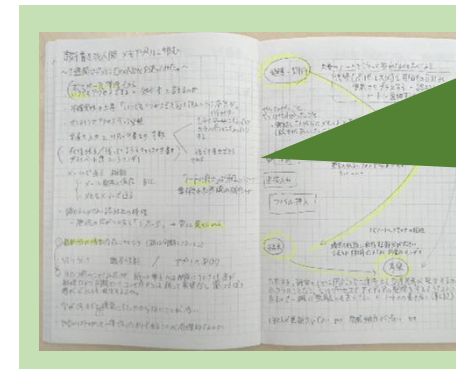
